UNISON – getting it right for healthcare students

You may be able to claim the cost of taking temporary accommodation near to your placement if it is not practical for you to travel there from your normal term time address.

The NHS Learning Support Fund pays a nightly allowance for students who need to use temporary accommodation while on placement. You can also claim extra cash to cover some of the cost of travelling between your normal term time accommodation and your temporary placement accommodation.

We know it's not enough but something is better than nothing. That's why you should claim it if you are entitled to it.
